

Plant cleaning

Every Ila creation comes with an **anti-dust technology**, embedded in the artificial foliage and flowers original PVC/Polyester batch. This prevents the dust, usually present in every environment, from settling and stacking into layers. Ila's design team usually provides the best solution, in term of foliage shape and colour, taking into account the different chance of dust stacking for every kind of environment.

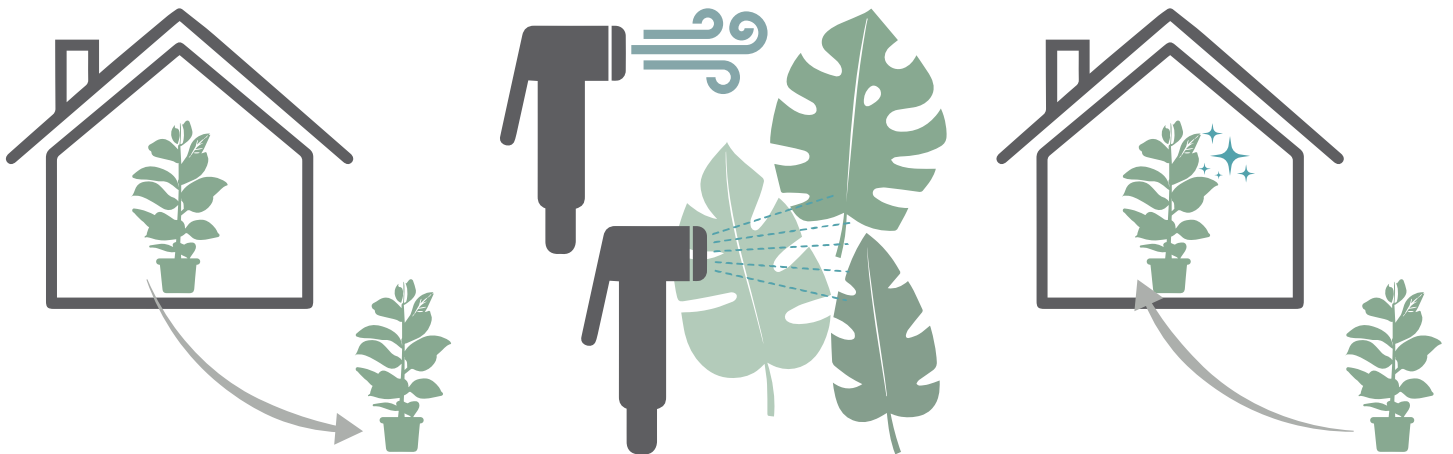
a. ORDINARY CLEANING

The best way to prevent dust from creating an unpleasant layer on foliage and flower surfaces is to keep them clean. Ila creations don't need a specific care, nor a frequent cleaning schedule, thanks to the anti-dust technology mentioned before. We recommend wiping leaves and flowers with a moist rag once in a while. This kind of cleaning process may occur **once every 6 months**, but the frequency ultimately depend on the indoor enviroment conditions and site features.

b. SPECIAL CLEANING

If for some reasons the plants collect an excessive amount of dust, or if the regular cleaning process is not carried out for too long, some deep cleaning may be needed.

We recommend following these steps:



1.Remove (if possible) the plants from their position, and store them in a open and ventilated area.

2.Carefully clean every leaf and flower surface, using air blowers and/or a water jet; then let the plants dry.

3.Adjust the canopy shape after cleaning, and bring the plants back to their usual location.

If it's impossible to remove plants and greeneries from their place, or if the plant is too large to be moved, we suggest wiping carefully every leaf or flower with a moist rag, using a gentle cleaning product if needed.
